

## HURON COUNTY 4-H CAMP RULES FOR BEHAVIOR

1. Be Nice!
2. Don't break Rule #1.
3. Respect others and their property. Use language and manners that are respectful. No foul language!
4. No fighting.
5. A raised hand means **Listen**. When you see someone with a raised hand, you also raise your hand, be quiet, and **Listen** for instructions.
6. Report all sickness and injuries to the counselors and nurse at once. All medication will be dispensed by the camp nurse. No medications are kept in the cabins. Items will be returned on the last day of camp.
7. **No cell phones, tablets, fitness trackers, smart watches or other electronic devices!** These devices should be left at home or they will be confiscated.
8. No swimming except during assigned times. Do not get closer to the river than the riverbank, except during supervised study sessions. No horseplay at the pond or river.
9. Shoes must be worn at all times except when showering, sleeping, swimming, or playing sand volleyball. Shoes must be worn from the cabin to the bathrooms and when going to and from the pond.
10. No running on trails or hills.
11. No sitting on the fence.
12. Anyone caught littering will be required to pick up litter for 10 minutes.
13. State law prohibits possession of drugs, alcoholic beverages, tobacco and nicotine products, firearms, hunting knives and other weapons as well as firecrackers and other kinds of fireworks at camp. Possession of such items will result in your immediate separation from the camp program. Your parents/guardians will be called, and transportation home will be arranged.
14. Campers must remain within the confines of the open camp (between cabins, river & woods) except during special sessions.
15. Campers are not permitted to leave camp at any time unless they have permission from the Camp Director and their parent/guardian. Campers who do leave camp (except for an emergency or medical treatment) are not permitted to return to the camping session.
16. Boys are **not** allowed in the girl's cabins and girls are **not** allowed in the boy's cabins, except during supervised sessions when at least two camp counselors are present.
17. No hats are to be worn during flag ceremonies, vespers and mealtimes.
18. All campers and counselors will sit by groups in assigned seats in the dining hall. Everyone at camp will participate in all meals. Proper manners are expected. No food or beverages may be brought into the dining hall. Nutritious balanced meals are provided; snacks brought from home are discouraged. Campers are **not** permitted in the kitchen.
19. Anyone caught throwing food, wasting food, or not wearing their name tag will be assigned an extra dish washing session and/or camp clean-up session. **NO WARNINGS!**
20. All campers must be in their cabin and quiet by lights out, and remain there until 6:30 a.m. Quiet hours are from lights out until 7:00 a.m. If you are someplace other than in your cabin, the bathroom, or the nurse's station after lights out, your parents/guardians will be called, and transportation home will be arranged.
