1. Applicant must be a current Huron County 4-H member.
2. Must be a graduating senior in the current school year.
3. Applicants must submit 2 letters of recommendation: one from your 4-H advisor and one from a schoolteacher.
4. Scholarship recipient will be announced prior to graduation but no money will be distributed until the first semester of post-high school work is completed, grades have been received, and second semester payment is made.
